MONKEYPOX

Take care of your health and help us slow the spread of monkeypox



Symptoms

- Fever
- Headaches
- Muscle aches
- Swollen lymph nodes
- Rash or blisters on any part of the body



Cases of disease called monkeypox have currently been found in many countries. The cases have mainly been identified among men who have sex with men.



Monitor for symptoms, especially if you have recently traveled abroad or have had sex with multiple partners.



You can get monkeypox if you have close physical contact with someone showing symptoms.
This includes both sexual and close face-to-face contact.



If you have symptoms or have been in close contact with someone with monkeypox avoid contact with others and contact healthcare by phone.



Monkeypox is usually mild, and most people recover without treatment. Symptoms typically last for 2-4 weeks.
